Bilingual Cantonese, Korean or Mandarin Case Manager

APCTC is a private, non-profit, community based mental health clinic with over 40 years of service to the Asian Pacific Islander community in Los Angeles County. Asian Pacific Counseling & Treatment Centers is a division of Special Service for Groups (SSG) and was the very first mental health center in LA County specifically developed to meet the unique needs of rapidly growing numbers of API immigrants and refugees who were in need of a wide range of mental health services. With six locations throughout LA County and a location in Riverside County, APCTC provides mental health services to individuals of all ages with diverse ethnic, gender and racial backgrounds, struggling with mental illness and behavioral health challenges. While our centers specialize in serving the monolingual Asian Pacific community, we provide services to the entire community and offer services in English and Spanish as well.

APCTC has a full-time position for a bilingual Cantonese, Korean or Mandarin Case Manager at our Wilshire Center (**1310 Wilshire Blvd., Los Angeles, CA 90017**). The Case Manager will be working with a team to assistance and support to adults and families who have moderate to severe mental illness. The Case Manager will provide linkage service to clients to access medical, educational, social, prevocational, rehabilitative, or other community services. The CM is responsible for monitoring service delivery, will provide cultural assistance and assist with crisis assessments and intervention. The CM is required to provide 24-hour psychiatric emergency coverage for clients and collaborate with hospitals, family members, law enforcement agencies and significant others.

Requirements: The candidate must have a Bachelor's degree in Human Services, Psychology, Social Work or related field. The candidate must have a strong interest and comfort level in working with all age, gender, ethnic groups and able to thrive in a fast-paced, team-focused environment. The candidate must be comfortable to work in the field and possess sensitivity towards people with disabilities. Candidate must have a valid California driver's license and reliable transportation. The candidate **MUST** be **proficient in Cantonese, Korean or Mandarin**. Knowledge of LAC-DMH paperwork is highly preferred.
