Psychiatric Social Worker – Associate Marriage & Family Therapist

APCTC is a private, non-profit, community based mental health clinic with over 30 years of service to the Asian Pacific Islander community in Los Angeles County. Asian Pacific Counseling & Treatment Centers is a division of Special Service for Groups (SSG) and was the very first mental health center in LA County specifically developed to meet the unique needs of rapidly growing numbers of API immigrants and refugees who needed a wide range of mental health services. While our centers specialize in serving the monolingual Asian Pacific community, we provide services to the entire community and offer services in English and Spanish as well.

APCTC has a full-time therapist position at our **Main Center location (520 S. La Fayette Park Pl. #300, Los Angeles, CA 90057)**. The candidate must **have experience working with LGBTQIA2S+ populations**. The therapist will be working with diverse age, racial, ethnic, gender groups who have moderate to persistent mental illness. Bilingual in one of the Asian Pacific Islander languages is highly desirable.

Responsibilities: Under the supervision of the Program Manager and Clinical Supervisor, the PSW/AMFT has primary clinical responsibilities in providing individual, group and family counseling, intake assessment, crisis intervention, case management and outreach services at our clinic, school-sites, client's home and community locations accessible to clients. The PSW/AMFT will spend a portion of their time providing mental health services in a program specifically for APIDA LGBTQIA2S+ populations. The PSW/AMFT will collaborate with inter-agency staff to serve our clients, including staff from schools, health care, DCFS, DPSS/GAIN, Probation Department, Regional Center, board and care facilities, etc. The PSW/AMFT must have effective time management and communication skills, and capable of working in a diverse, interdisciplinary team of psychiatrists, therapists, case managers, substance abuse counselor, parent partner, etc.

Requirements: Candidate must have master's degree in Social Work or Marriage and Family Therapy from an accredited college or university. We are looking for candidates who have a passion to help under-served API ethnic populations and interested in gaining experience in community mental health. The candidate must have knowledge/training in the DSM-V and able to adapt to a fast-paced work environment. Candidate must have a valid registration with BBS, a valid California driver's license and reliable transportation. The candidate must **have experience working with LGBTQIA2S+ communities**. Bilingual in one of the Asian Pacific Islander languages is highly desirable. Knowledge of LAC-DMH paperwork is highly preferred.

Pay & Benefits: DOE. Pay is competitive plus mileage reimbursement. SSG/APCTC includes a generous benefits package with medical, dental, vision, long term disability, group and term life insurance, defined pension plan, 403B, paid sick, vacation and holiday time. We support licensure of staff and provide on-going supervision by licensed clinicians.
